### Quick caregiver checklist

	Checklist item
<input type="checkbox"/>	Show the dog's normal entry route to the bed, couch, or sleep area.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Point out any ramps, stairs, rugs, or traction zones that should stay in place.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Mark where cleanup supplies and spare bedding are stored.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Leave one sentence on what the caregiver should do if the dog refuses the setup.

Keep this sheet practical. It is a handoff note, not medical instructions.
